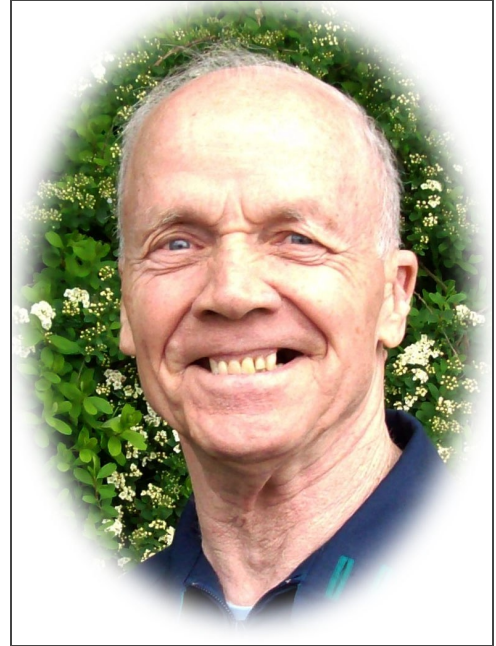


# Arthur "Bud" Samuel Clarke
