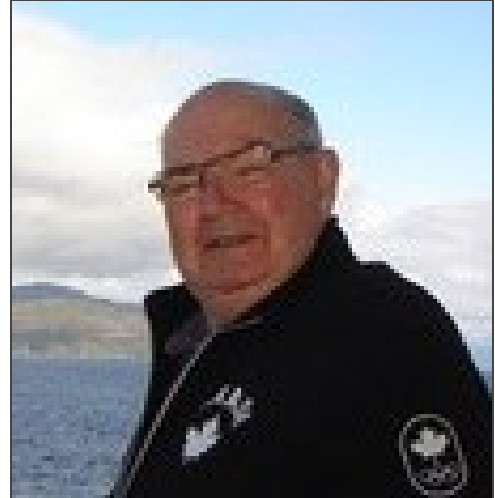


Harvey Charles Coatham
