It is with great sadness we announce the peaceful passing of our father Carlos Cobarrubia on Sunday, Sept 5 at Richmond General Hospital at age 88.

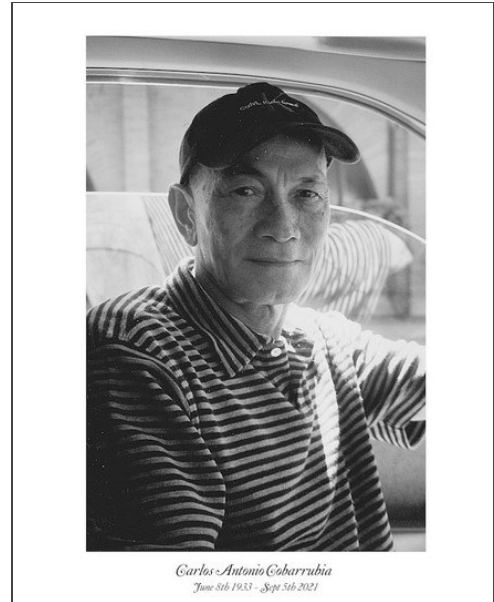
Carlos was born and raised in Cavite City, Philippines into a large family of 10 brothers and sisters. Carlos moved to Canada
