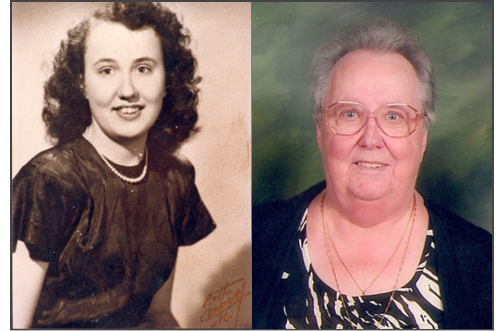


Theresa Coulombe
