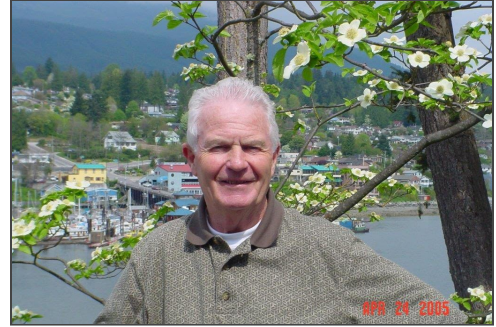


Ronald Bryce Cumiskey
