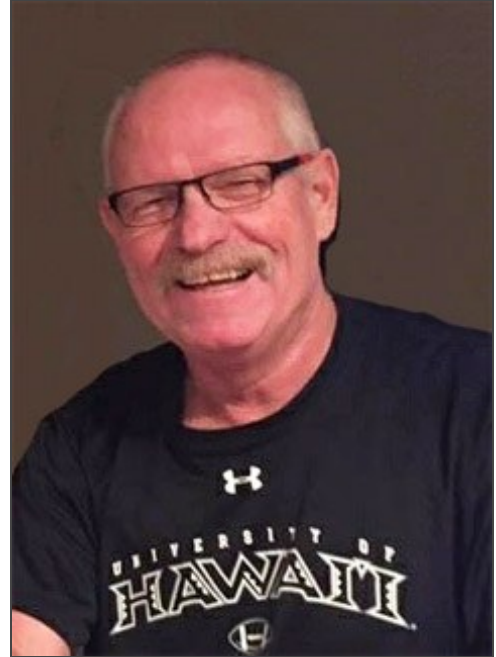


Michael John Edward Currie
