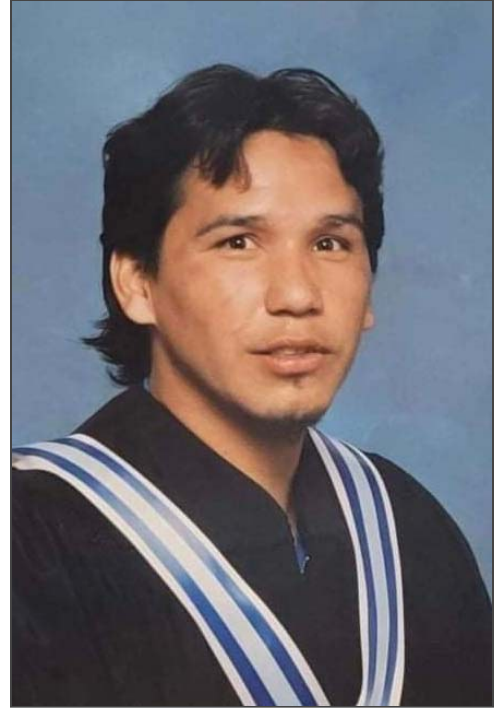


# Ian Jorge Cyr
