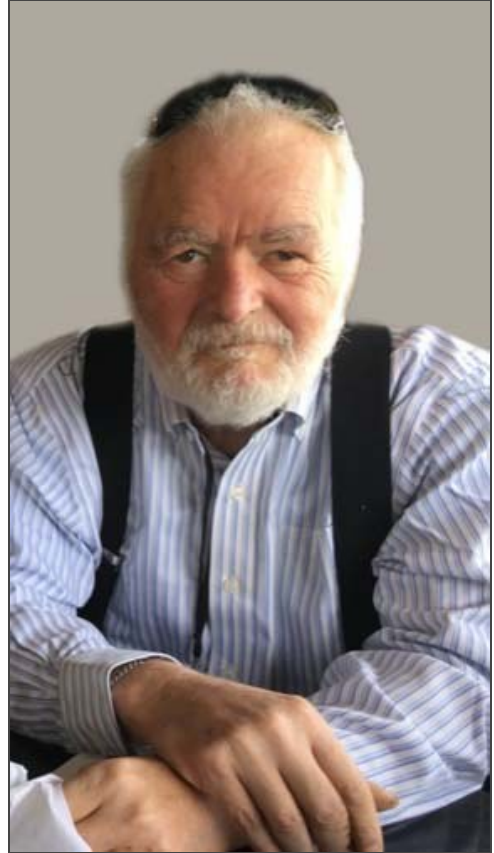


Willi L. Daechert
