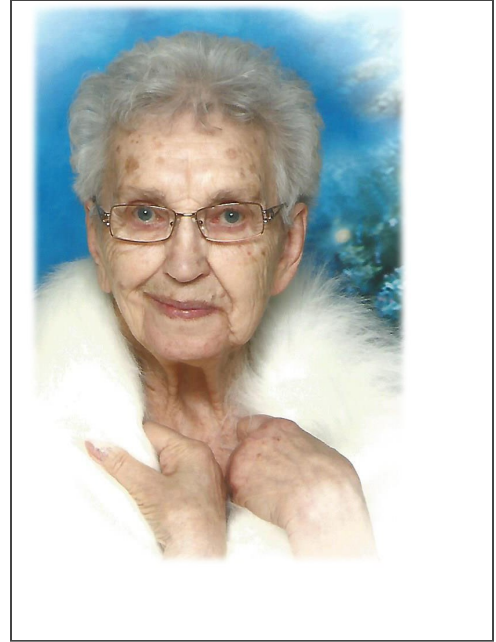


# Mary Davidson
