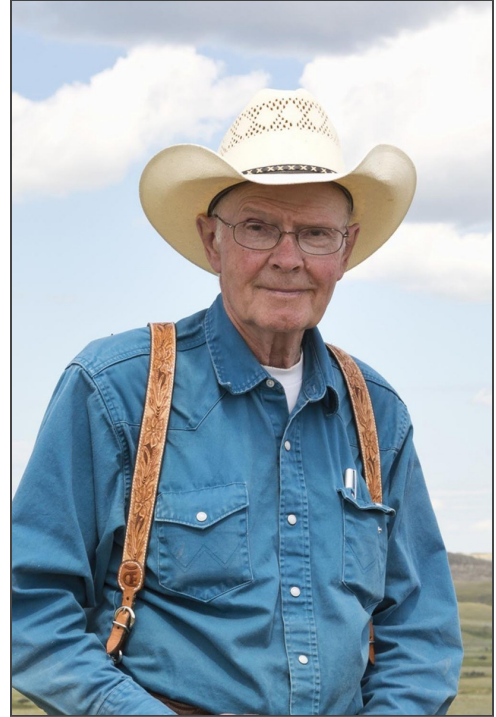


# Floyd Lloyd Dawson
