

Leo Joseph DeDecker

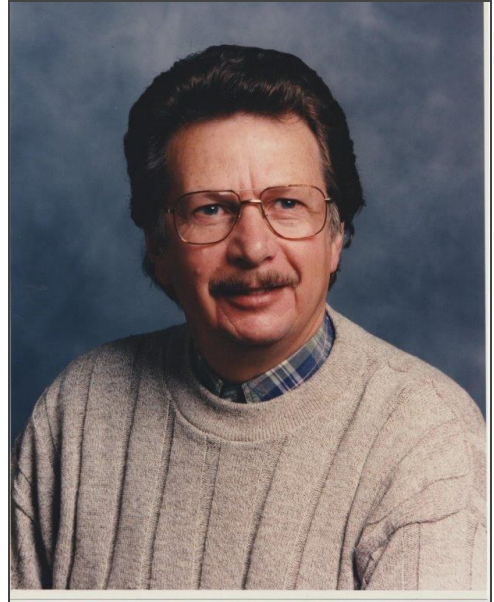
