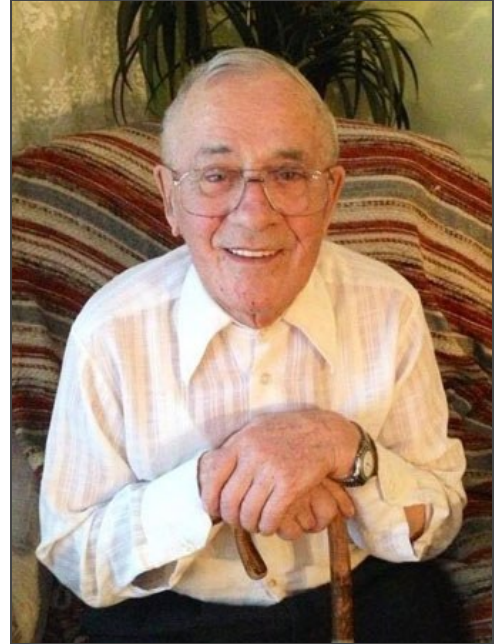


Mykola "Nick" Demchyshyn
