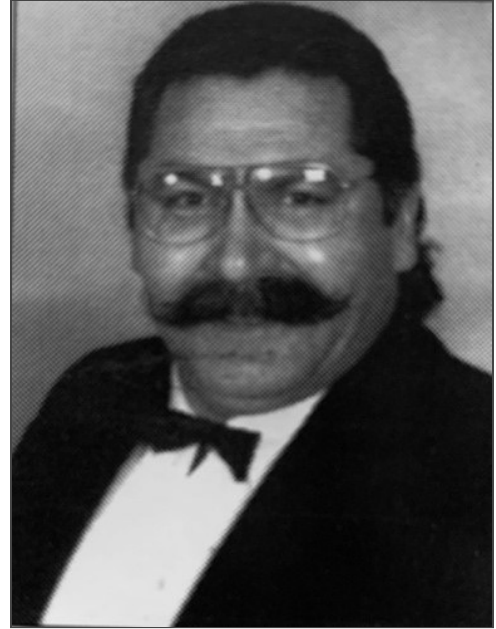


Alfred "Sonny" Desjarlais
