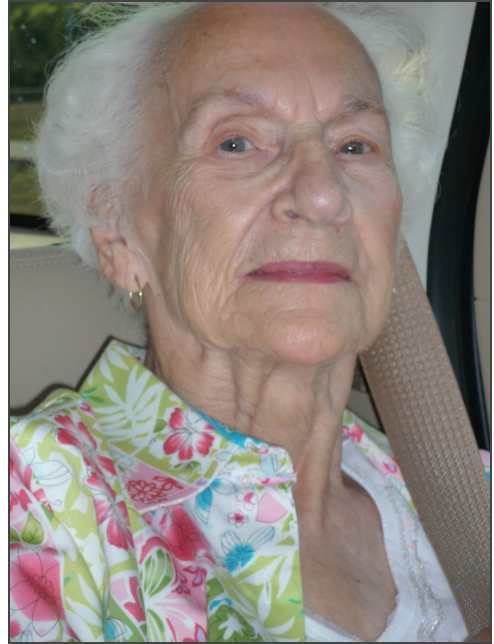


Verva Irene Desrosiers

Our mother, the oldest of five children was born in Topeka, Kansas on September 8, 1923. Shortly after her birth, she and her parents immigrated to the Purdue area in Saskatchewan. She attended Normal School in Saskatoon where her main area of study was primary education. She and dad were married after the war and they eventually moved to Regina where dad continued to teach and mom raised her seven children. Two of her children were deaf and one of mom's greatest accomplishments in life was being instrumental in the formation of a pre-school for the deaf in Regina.



Mom succumbed to pneumonia in the Regina General Hospital on Saturday, December 20, 2014 after a brief hospitalization. Her passing was peaceful, with family at her side. Prior to her death, all of her children were able to visit.

She was predeceased by her parents; husband Ted; son David; brothers and numerous in-laws.
