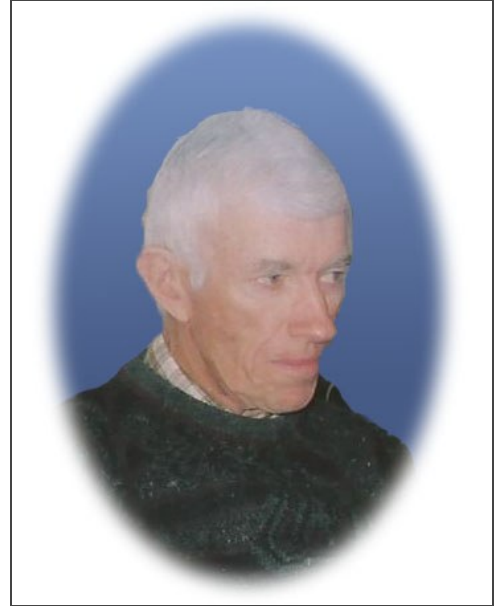
DEVOLIN, Ron
