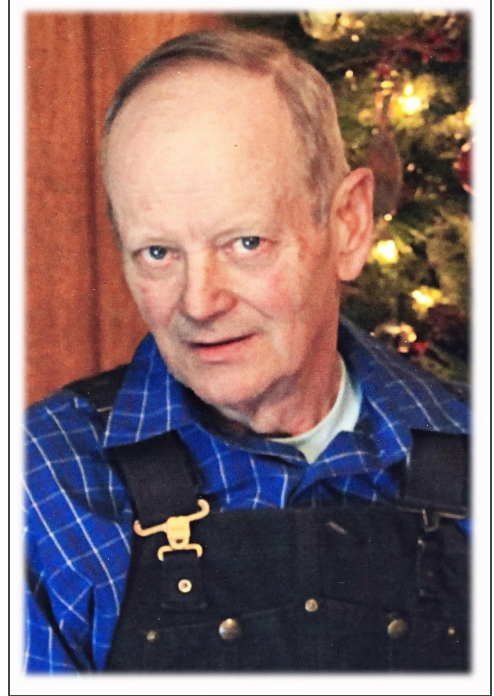


# Barry F.R. DeWindt
