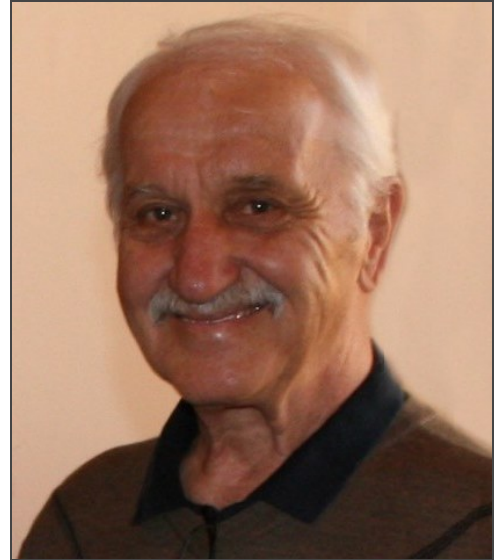


Bill Dinu
