March 15, 1930 - March 3, 2026

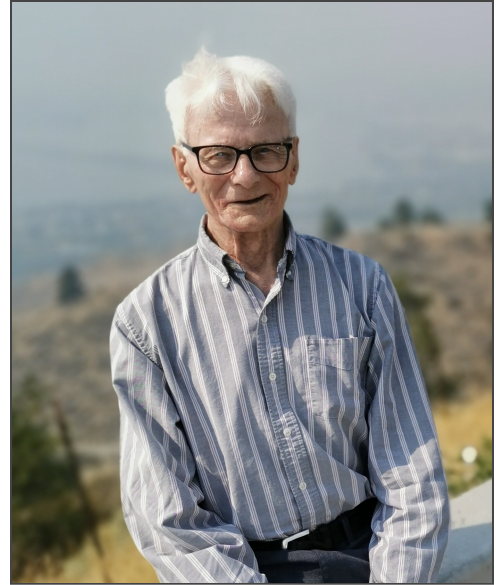
