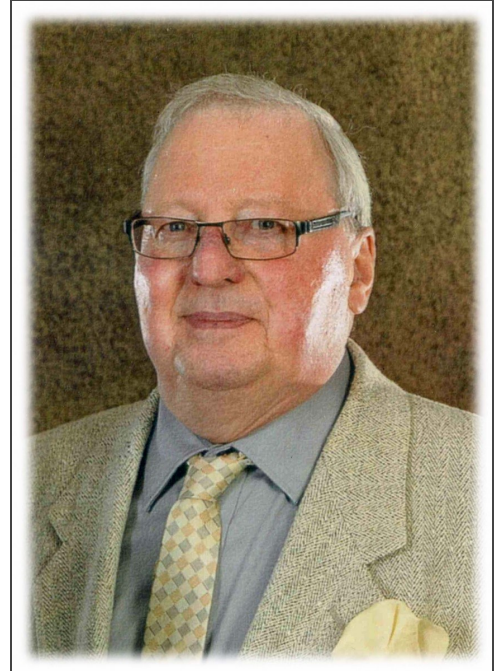


Gerald "Gerry" Dorosh

It is with great sadness that the family of Gerry Dorosh announces his passing on September 20, 2022 at the age of 74. Gerry was born in Ituna, Saskatchewan on June 22, 1948. He was the oldest of 3 children, growing up on the family farm outside the town of Ituna, Saskatchewan.



Gerry was predeceased by his parents Bob and Eleanor Dorosh as well as his younger brother Glen Dorosh of Ituna, Saskatchewan.

Gerry moved to Regina, Saskatchewan and started his working life in the construction industry. He moved on to Intercontinental Packers and after 8 years he began a career working within the local trucking industry, driving for Motorways and Kindersley Transport. Gerry loved music. Playing guitar from a young age, music was his passion. He would listen to music and sing for hours, one of his favorites being the Mule Skinner Blues. Gerry singing this song was one of the highlights of many Christmas celebrations and house parties.

Gerry will be lovingly remembered by his wife of 52 years Marlene and his daughters Shantel (Derrick) and Tyra. He will also be remembered by his grandchildren Justin and Tylan and his two fur grandbabies Ginny and Barkley. Gerry will be looking down and watching over his sister Geraldine (Larry) Parks, his many brothers and sisters-in-law and countless nieces and nephews.
