

Dale Daniel Dorsch

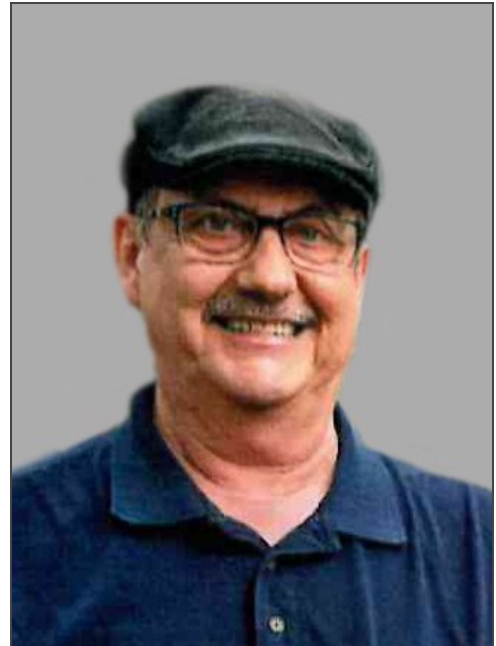
