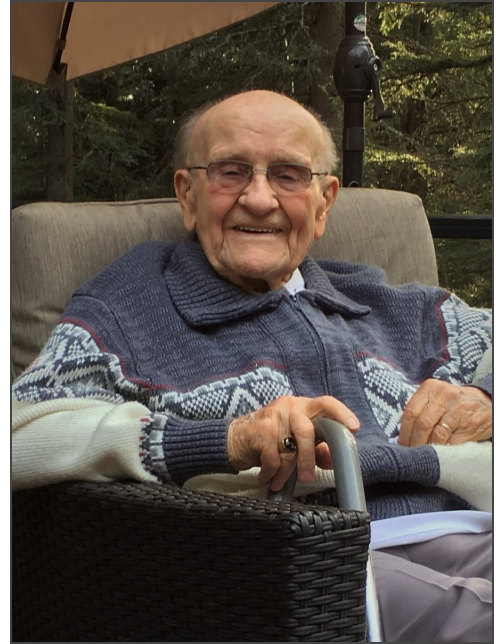


Peter P. Driedger
