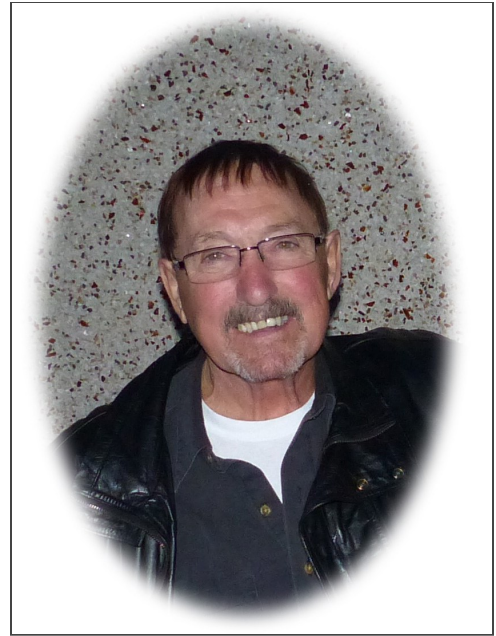


Steve George Drobot
