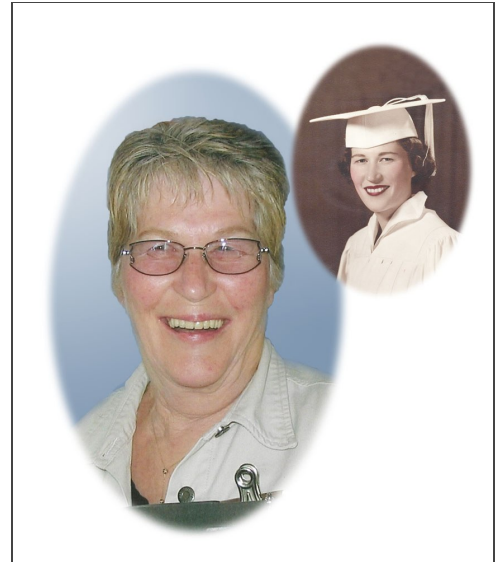


Marie-Paule Bernadette Dubois

Born in Moose Jaw on October 13, 1936, Marie grew up on a farm near Courval, Saskatchewan with her parents Bernadette & Paul Croteau, and siblings Térèse (OMI), Monique (Victor), Wilfred (Doris), Raymond (Terry) and Clarice (Michael).
