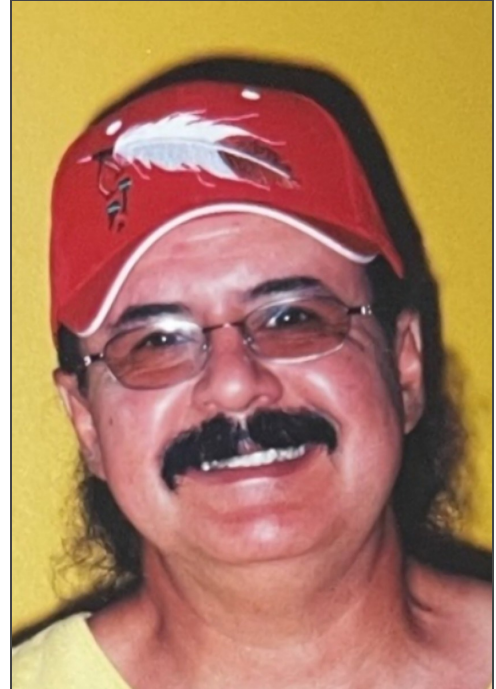


Gerald Wayne Dufour
