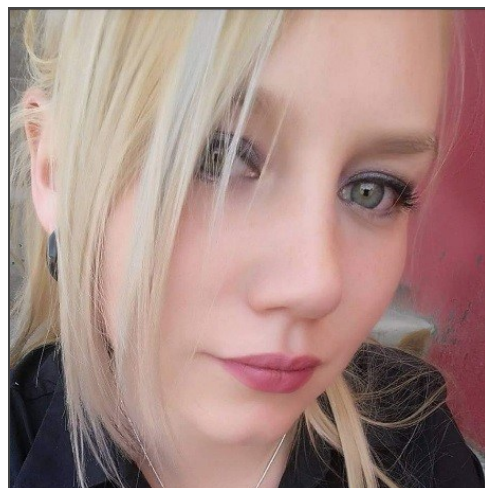


Julie Catherine Duncan
