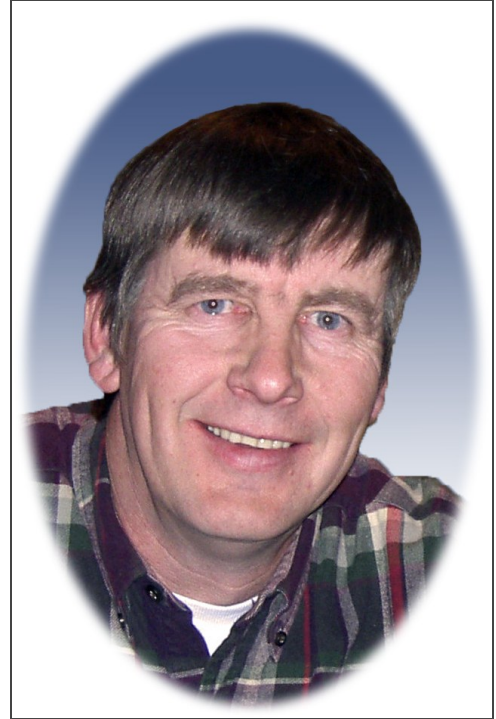


Albert Dykstra
