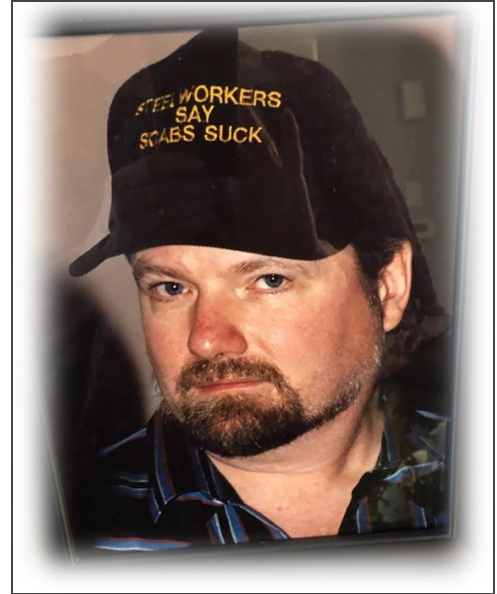


# Clarence Archie Eden
