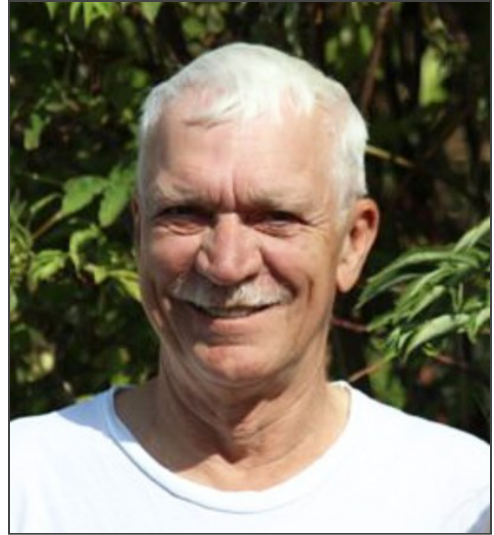


# Harold Wesley Elliott
