Our family is deeply saddened to announce that Bill McLean passed away on August 5, 2025.

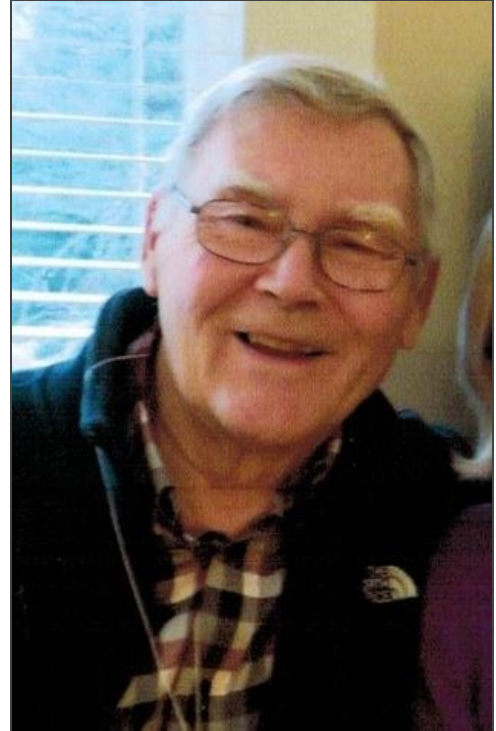
An aggressive cancer took his life from his loved ones gathered around him.

logging roads, canoeing lakes with friends and their kids, family potluck suppers on the weekends, made a lifelong impression on all of us.
