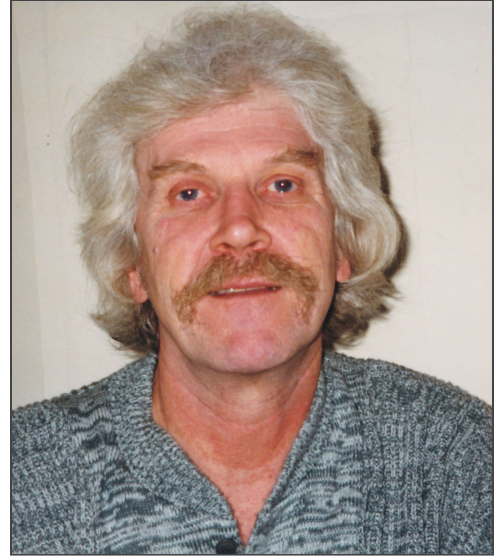


Geoffrey Thomas Evans
