

Henry Owen Farmer

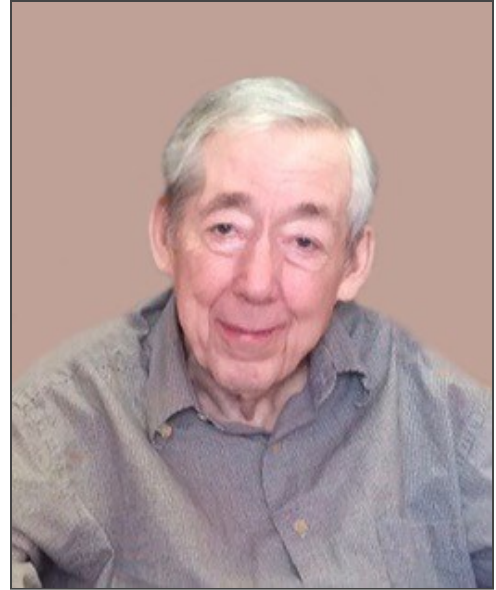
