He left behind his wife of 22 years, Debbie;

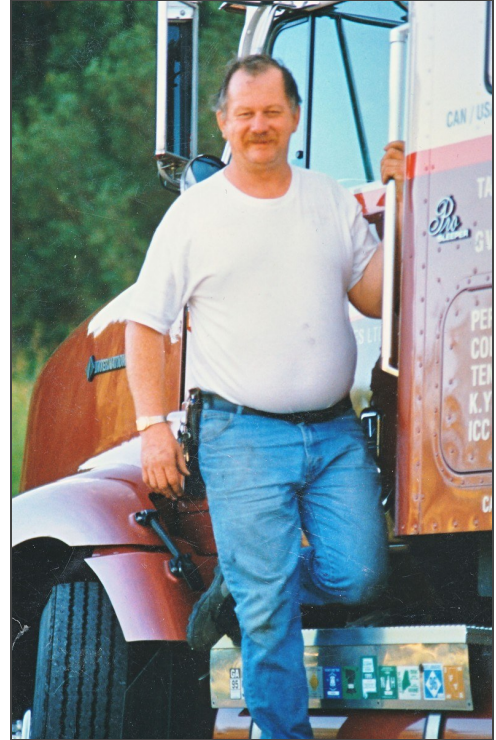
daughter, Patty Rhodes; son, Cody Murray
