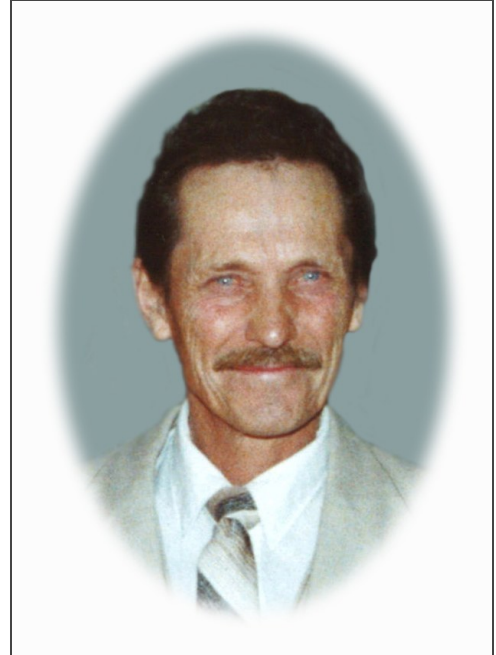


# Albert John Frank
