Fred continued to be involved in the community and served as alderman for several terms and was elected Mayor. Winters were spent in Arizona, where Fred and Denise lived in Carriage Manor.

Fred enjoyed many activities including happy hours with friends, golfing and serving on the park council. He took up jewelry making and produced many beautiful pieces which Denise enjoys.
