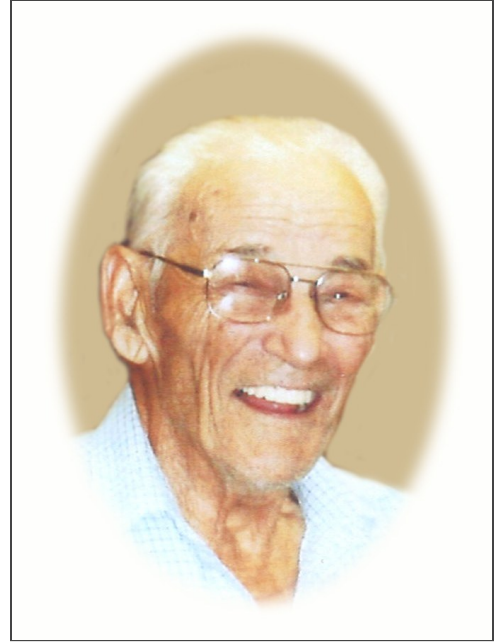


Joseph Auguste Frigon
