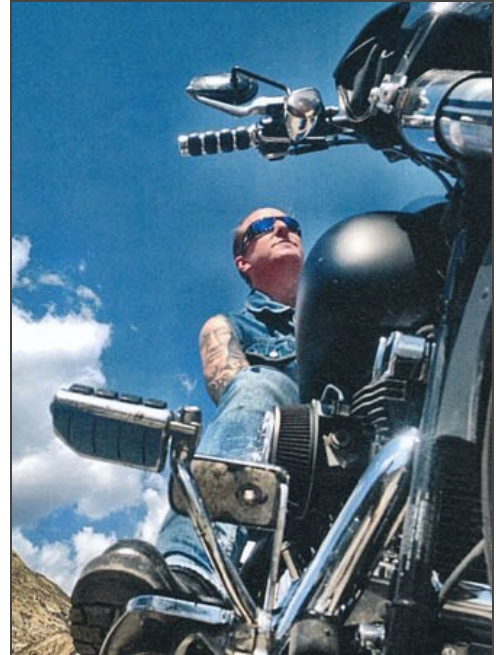
FULLERTON, Darcy Donald
