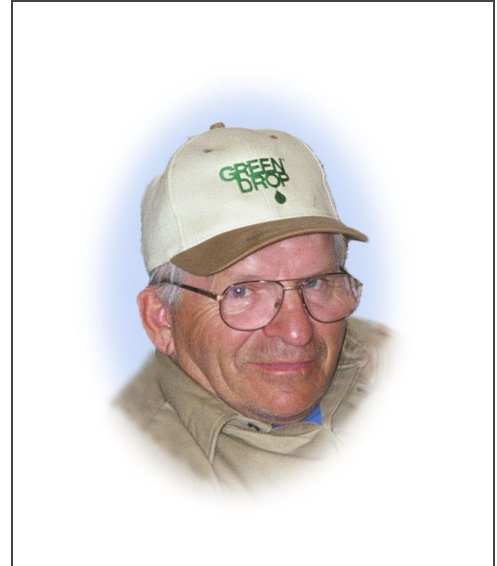


Roy Brenton Fulton
