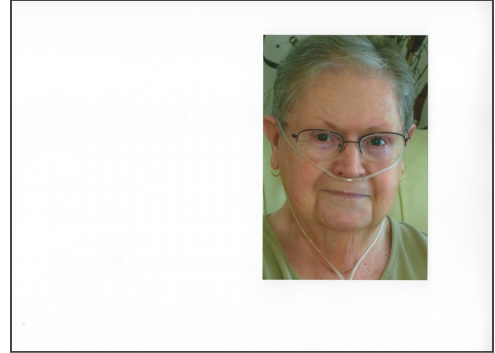


# Florence Shirley Fyke
