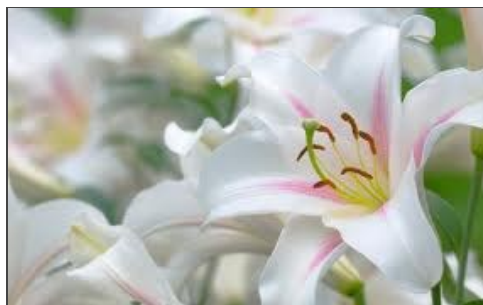


# Jeannette Dragoon Galbraith
