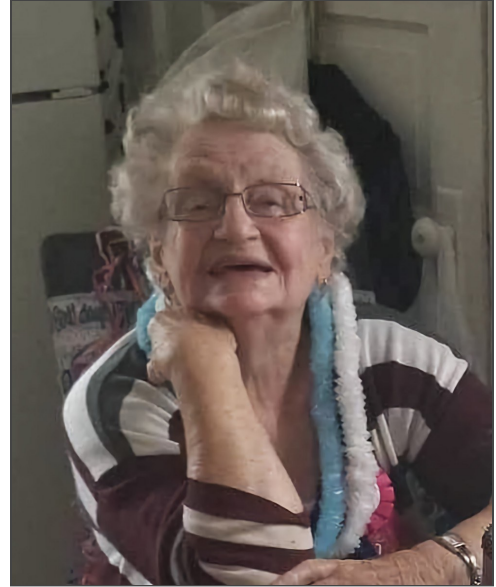


# Violet Lousie Gallant
