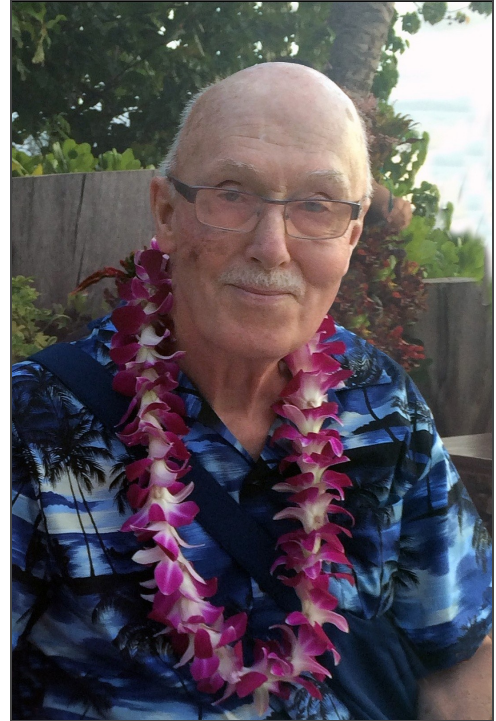


George Beckett
