

Eileen Gherasim

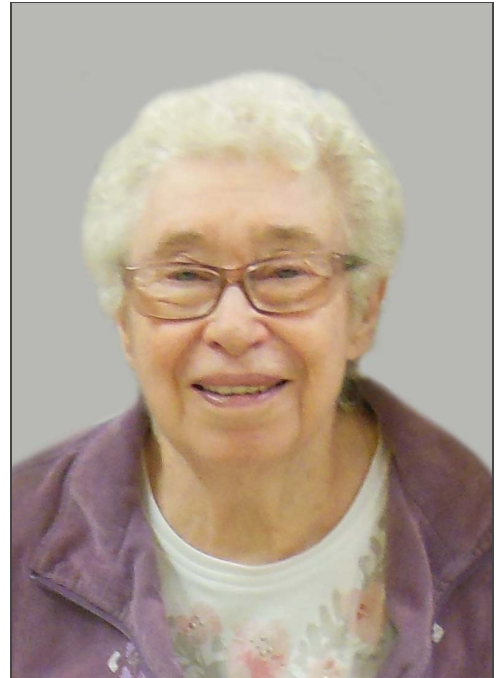
