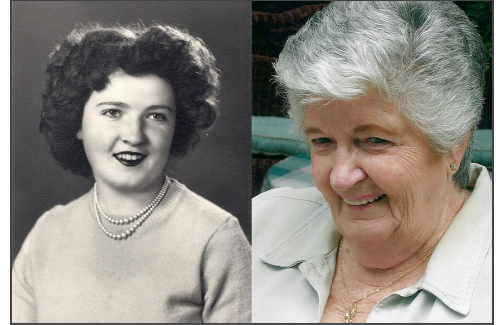


Dorothy Bernice Giesz
