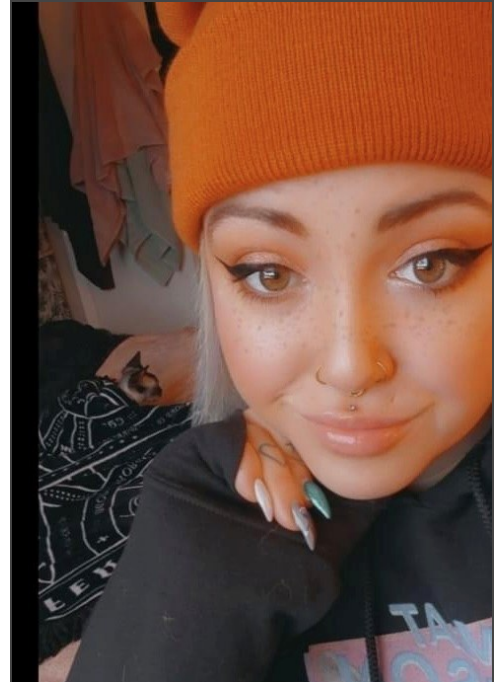
It is with deep sadness we announce the passing of our daughter, sister and friend Chantelle Giroux on December 9, 2022 in Regina, Saskatchewan.
