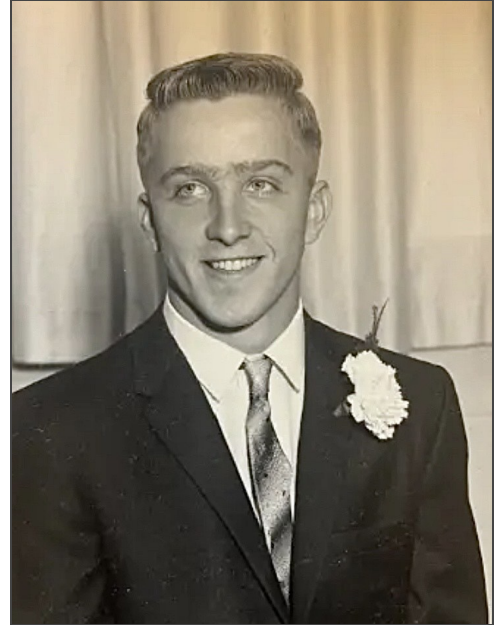


Glenn Allan Larson
