

# Kori Goldney- Bordignon

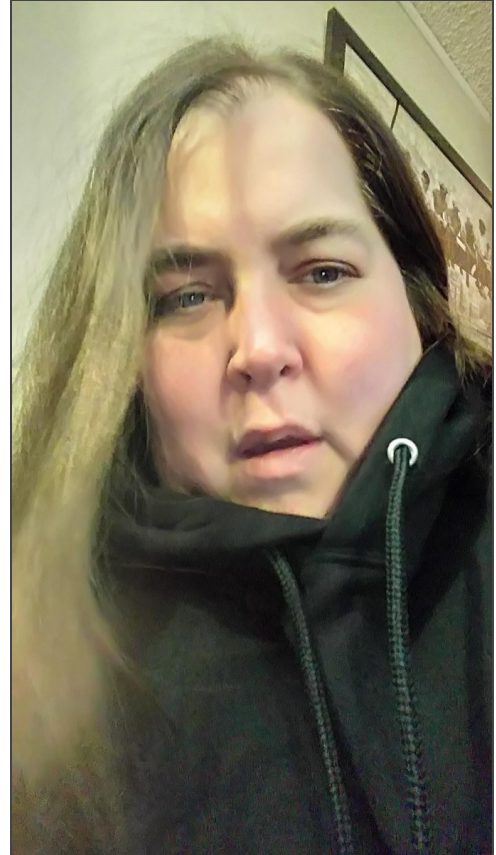
