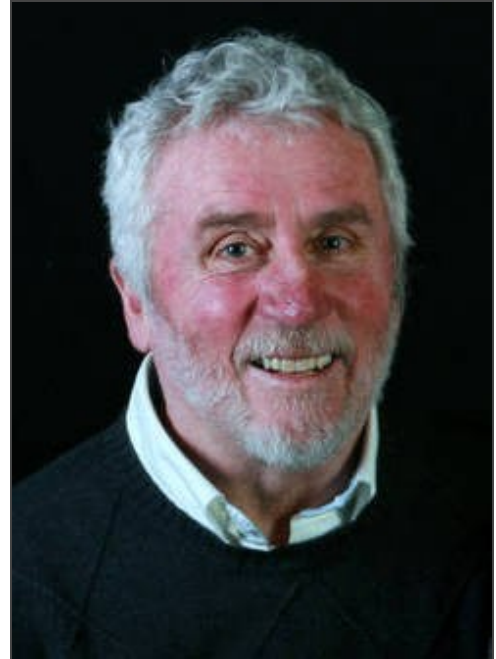


Robert (Bob) John Grad
