Len was born and grew up in Windsor, Ontario. He graduated from Assumption High School where he enjoyed the many opportunities to play basketball, football, baseball and golf.

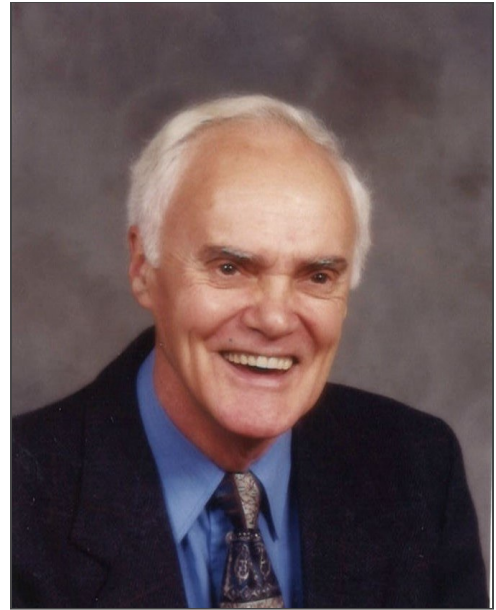
