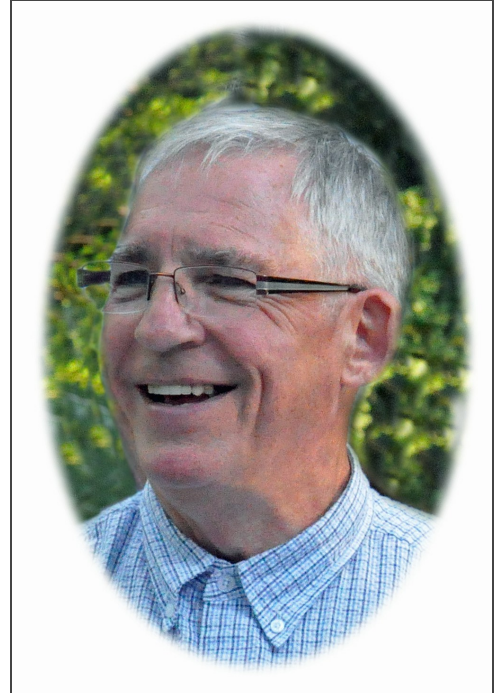


# David Howard Green
