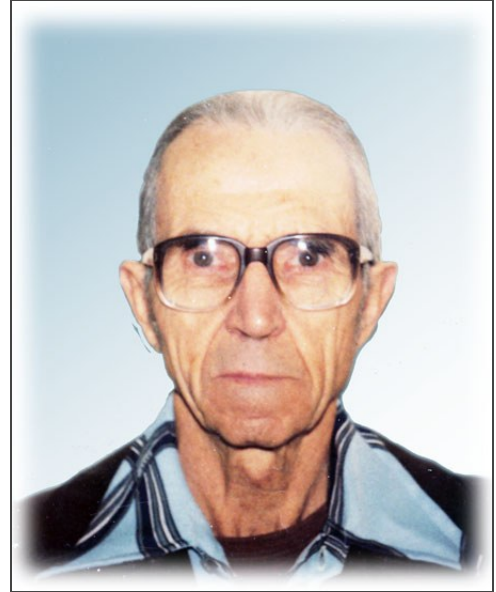


# Lawrence Michael Greif
